this my last will and testament in manner and
form following (Viz)

1st I give and bequeath to my Daughter Win-
-ifred Darnall four bags the largest of my
bags; forty bushels of Corn two feather beds
and furniture and my Chest of Drawers forever

2^d my two negroes Sandy and Rachel I will
to be sold and the money arising from
such sale I will to be Equally divided among
my three daughters Winifred Darnall, Elizabeth
Calhoun and Jane W. Rivers each to have an
equal share forever -

3^d I send to my Son Elijah Cunningham the
plantation whereon I now live together

With all my land, my Stock of every Description
my Wagon and Farming utensils, and other
tools of every Description, all the remainder of
my household and kitchen furniture that is
that above Will, together with all of my
Crops, and all the rest residue and remains
of my property of whatever kind & nature exist
What I have given to my grand Daughter
~~a deed of gift~~ Elizabeth M. A Cunningham
in a deed of gift - after paying all my Last
Debts, I also appoint Elijah Cunningham
acting agent for his children during his
life to transact the business for them
in any way or manner he may think
most advisable for their advantage, and
after his Death whatever property he may
not have disposed of in raising, supporting
and educating his children, I will it to
be sold and the money arising from
such sale to be equally divided among
all his children at his Death, the above
property in this sense being entirely Will'd

for the use of my Son Elijah Seemingly born
Chelbren. and part of it now the grapes that
are raised on the land can be taken to pay
my said Sons debts.

I ^{the} and lastly I nominate and appoint
my friend Bay "Person of South Carolina
and my Son Elijah Seemingly born Executors
to this my last will and Testament. hereby
revoking all former wills by me made
in witness whereof I have hereunto set my
hand and seal this twentieth day
of October in the year of our Lord one thou-
sand eight hundred and thirty
my Daughter Minnie Barnett is
to live in the house where Nathaniel Seemingly born
Elijah lives
